"Easter at Alberton" - A devotional thought from...

"At the sixth hour, darkness came over the whole land until the ninth hour. Jesus cried out in a loud voice: 'My God, My God why have You forsaken Me?'" Mark 15: 33

We had left the church on Good Friday in solemn silence - the clear image of the cross before us from the Scripture readings went with us. Remarks were made about the recent viewings of the movie "The Passion of the Christ," how it heightened our awareness ... we were now in a state of waiting - the mood of the day enshrouding us.

"Very early on the first day of the week, they (the women) were on their way to the tomb." Mark 16:2

Sunday Morning ...4:30 a.m. - Alberton Parish - darkness - 5:30 a.m. Husband in his usual devotion to the particulars of preparations - 'Marthaesque' (Editor's note: this is a reference to one of the times Jesus has a meal with Mary and Martha - cf. Luke 10:38 - 42.) In a flurry, hubby was over at the church next door, collecting the various items needed (Communion vessels, cloths for the altar) to prepare for the dawn service on the hill. [DRAMA!] The organ still had to be transported to the site and the cross was missing. (It had been taken home for repairs by a helping hand after a mishap at the Good Friday Service.)

Year after year, there are same procedures, the same time-line, leaving we lesser mortals to arise slowly and with groaning effort. There is a piercing chill and our kids would seek to hold us back in their warmth. ... 5:55 a.m. - The car approaches the unpredictable farm track. ('Martha' was long time in front of us; and thanks to all the Marthas,

all is waiting.) Wary of the sandy farm track, with its sudden ruts and grooves we travel with care... All is well! The canyons have been filled with soil and levelled for this special occasion. We will soon be there at the dawn service without the customary bumps.

As with each Lenten journey, with each precious year, we are travelling to the top of the hill, to the joyful end - the summit. The reddish glow of the soon-to-emerge-sun is shining on the horizon as we reach the top. 6:05 a.m. - The congregation is standing - in the middle of the paddock with simple altar in place, voices raised in Hallelujahs! ('Martha' is brandishing programs at late-comers.)

He is risen!...Oh, what sweet comfort. The sun rises in glorious splendour over the surrounding country - over the river, the patchwork canefields and the shining grasses down into the valley to the length and breadth of our vision. We again rejoice collectively in the climax of our salvation: He is risen! The freshly baked Communion bread and the wine are passed from person to person - true body and true blood, - in remembrance of Him who died - The Risen Lord, Jesus.

As the chairs are stacked and the warm voices chat over coffee and Hot Cross Buns - a new day has begun. ('Martha' collects the programs so they can be recycled for the later Easter service at our sister church in the parish... or maybe even next year.) Down the hill the cars slowly weave in quiet, calm certainty - Mission Accomplished. Mission begun! The items of worship are returned to the empty church; but with the certainty of the empty tomb.
