### From Pastor's Pen

I'm in the process of clearing away duplicates of old Bulletins and past "Messengers" at the moment. This type of office 'administrivia' is becoming less taxing as time goes by and things are stored electronically. The 'paperless' society, however, is still far from a reality. As I go through the process, I can become caught up in reading 'old news'; and being amazed at the memories that flood back. Was that really five years ago that those events took place? ☺ ; or, 'I remember that!'

Lutheran Holiday Program was that kind of experience for me too. Even though I was only able to be at Lutheran Holiday Program for one day this year because our Church's General Convention of Synod was on at the same time, it was a fascinating day. One of the mums, who stayed for the day to see her child settle in, was listening to the Bible account of Jesus helping His disciples to learn to pray. The light shone from her face as she revisited the story as an adult. "I haven't heard that in years!" she exclaimed. More than looking through old bulletins and having a happy memory, she was looking back into her own life and seeing a time when Jesus had been a joy to her; and she recognised that she wanted to hear the things she remembered from Scripture classes and Sunday school. There she was, 'surprised by joy' that she was getting something from a children's program. Here was Jesus helping her to value afresh what she hadn't considered vital in a long time.

She moved on with the ring of the bell to the next segment of the morning and I remained with the activity I was helping to run. That was my bit of joy that morning and I hope the experience of the children and mums who heard the good news lasts in their hearts and grows.

The prophet Isaiah promises God's people that His word always achieves its goal – God's plan is fulfilled. Nothing excites me more than that promise nor gives my human side a greater concern. The two sides of the internal discussion I have with myself are: "How can reading or hearing the Bible do that?" and then "What if it doesn't work like it's supposed to?"

The Holy Spirit, who renews my life, draws me to answer my questions with quotes from Scripture:

**I am not ashamed of the Gospel, because it is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes; ...for in the Gospel a righteousness is revealed, a righteousness that is by faith from first to last, just as it is written: The righteous will live by faith."**

Romans 1: 16 & 17

"What if it doesn't work?" Well I can't stop the process of people rejecting the Good News, but I can share it with others and let God do his work as planned. It's His promise, not mine. Expose yourself to the Bible, which is no ordinary story and test out God's promise for yourself. May you be surprised by joy and renewed in your spirit.

### FROM PRINCIPAL OF LORDS: GARTH HUNT

The amended development application for LORDS was submitted to Gold Coast City Council on 5<sup>th</sup> October.

By the time you read this article we should have our Acknowledgement Notice which will allow us to formally present the documentation to the concurrence agencies. These are the Office of Urban Management, Department of Natural Resources and Mines, and the Environmental Protection Agency.

Our legal and town planning team are confident that our amended application meets the requirements of the GCCC and the concurrence agencies.

The key concurrence agency remains the OUM. From our meetings during the past twelve months they are aware of the details of our application and have promised to complete their part of the process within 2 weeks of formally receiving our application. However, LORDS will be the first application to test the twin criteria of location and community need under the regulations of the South East Queensland Regional Plan.

Our next step is to meet with our local politicians to ensure they are aware of the details of our amended application. In this regard, Margaret Keech has been very proactive in supporting our work and assisting in brokering a number of key meetings.

When we enter the Public Notification stage I would ask each of our supporters to write letters of support. I will provide more details of this at a later date.

I thank you for your prayers and the continued support of the Alberton Parish. Each week we receive enrolment enquiries at our office. The community is eagerly waiting for us to be able to confirm our commencement date.

### Lutheran Holiday Program 2006

Our program for this year is over and planning has begun for 2007.

We had 95 children attend and, even though our helper numbers were down on previous years, we all survived the busy few days. Some of the highlights were:-

- the children learning the Lord's Prayer – working through each of the petitions
- we had a temporary fence keeping all the children safe from the busy road
- we raised over \$500 to support the Australian Lutheran World Service project in Sudan
- we had a visit from the "Mouse Circus"
- the pre-school/kindy had a visit from a boat and a jeep and a brown snake
- 12 chickens kept the children entertained each day
- the daily skits kept us on the edge of our seats waiting for the capture of the "blue cheeked bee eater" by Bakari
- 300 or more people attended our closing concert on Friday evening

A huge thank you to those members of parish who attended at the program and helped us each day; and also to those who helped in any way before or after the program. We can't run this important mission without your help. At this stage it looks like our program for 2007 will be Son Treasure Island.

After 16 years of the successful program running in our parish, I would like to make a major change. This change would entail the program being run over 5 half days instead of the current 2 ½ day program. I believe the children will benefit from a little longer time in each session and only learning one Biblical Principal each day. I would appreciate your feed-back on this idea (good and bad). Nothing has been finalised as yet in this area.

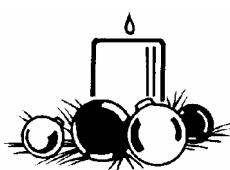
Following the service we celebrate further by having dinner together in the hall. Each family is asked to bring along a main course and a dessert to share.
